Catholic Charities Second Century Strategic Blueprint — 2024–2028

Addressing the ongoing and emerging needs of New Yorkers

For over a century Catholic Charities has helped to solve the problems of New Yorkers in need — non-Catholics and Catholics alike. In developing its Second Century Strategic Blueprint Catholic Charities trustees and management re-affirmed its mission while taking a hard look at its existing programs and its federation of affiliated independent agencies. Priority initiatives were identified to address the current and future needs of New Yorkers from 2024–2028.

The Catholic Charities Second Century Fund has been established to raise the considerable philanthropic resources needed by Catholic Charities to implement programs and services included in the Second Century Strategic Blueprint. These resources will be used to meet the ongoing, emerging, and newly identified needs of New Yorkers.

High priority programmatic initiatives are:

- stabilizing housing for lower income New Yorkers
- building new affordable housing for families and those with special needs
- providing nutritious supplemental food
- supporting those with mental illnesses
- supporting and integrating immigrants and refugees
- responding to community emergencies and disasters

Funds donated to the Second Century Fund will be carefully stewarded and monitored to ensure they are expended in accord with the intent of donors.
