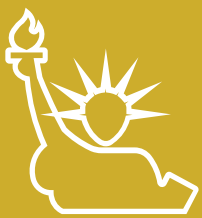

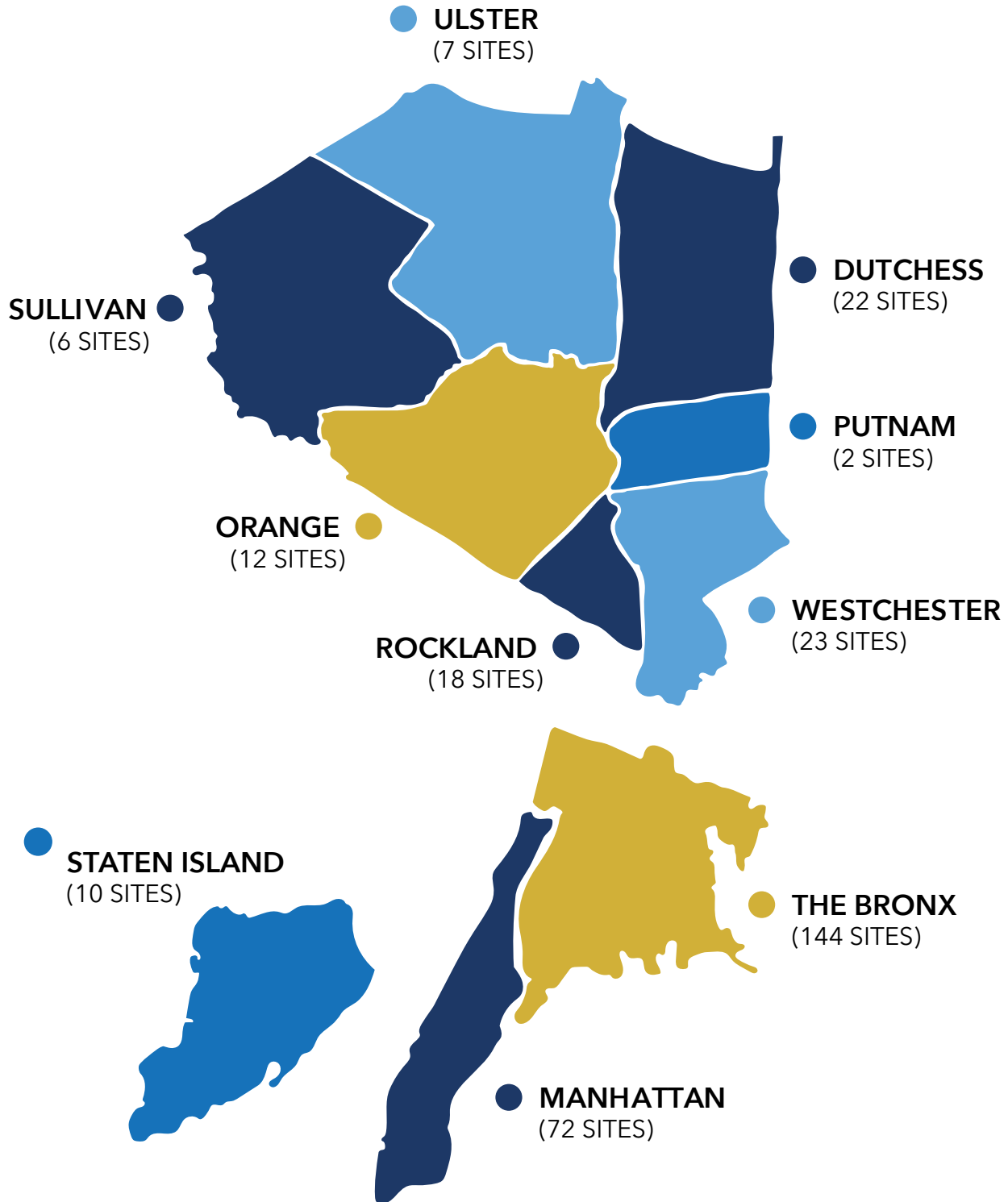

Feeding Our Neighbors

10+ Million Meals Served

Hunger is a fundamental threat to human life and dignity and demands our immediate and ongoing attention. An estimated 1.5 million New York City residents don't have enough food. One in four are children. With the high cost of food, visits to food pantries are on the rise.

Feeding for Our Neighbors

Through our lifesaving food programs, we use our large network of food pantries, community soup kitchens, mobile pantries, meal delivery services to the homebound, and a food distribution hub to provide food for 50,000 New Yorkers every month.

Creating Hope Amid Rising Need

No one should have to decide between rent and food. Our food programs distribute food to families and individuals who cannot afford to visit a local supermarket or grocery store.

Dedicated volunteers typically provide a three-to-seven-day supply of groceries based on family size. Our food pantries allow those in need to stretch their budgets and prepare nutritious meals with fresh produce, meat, poultry, and non-perishable food items.

Our community soup kitchens serve hot, nutritious meals with warm smiles to many individuals and families in areas across New York. We also deliver meals to the homebound, especially senior citizens.

Responding to Emergencies

When we identify specific areas where there is an immediate need for more food, Catholic Charities of New York springs into action to deploy an emergency food distribution to help meet the needs of a community in crisis. During these emergency distributions, we drive food

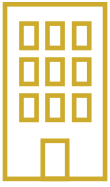
trucks directly into the affected area. Boxes and bags of shelf-stable and fresh foods are distributed to the people who line up around the block.

Behind the Scenes at Bronx Food Hub

At our Bronx Food Hub, you will find volunteer Fard Shaheed. "Hunger is a very serious issue in our community," says Mr. Shaheed.

Mr. Shaheed knows what it's like to wonder where his next meal is coming from. As a child, his family lived in a shelter after they lost their apartment to a fire. As an adult, he also experienced homelessness. "I know how it feels to go without," he says.

Now that Mr. Shaheed is in a better place, he is at the Bronx Food Hub three times a week, helping more than a thousand people each week. "Whether to pay bills or put food on the table, it's a harsh decision for people to make," Mr. Shaheed says. "It's unfortunate that people are forced to make that decision. But by volunteering, we're able to take some of the stress off them."



Sheltering the Homeless

16,000+ Individuals Helped

We all need a place to call home. For many of our struggling neighbors, Catholic Charities of New York provides shelter to the most vulnerable – with dignity, love, and respect. In the last year, homelessness has risen in New York City. Nearly 100,000 people are homeless. The vast majority are families – mothers and children. This is a crisis. Every New Yorker deserves a home.

Our 2023 Impact

- 16,000+ homeless individuals helped
- 4,300+ families provided financial assistance
- 4,800+ evictions prevented
- 1,600+ people provided emergency shelter

Preventing Eviction

It is essential to keep families together and in their homes. Our caseworkers help to find solutions to keep families stable and in their homes, so they don't end up in the shelter system or on the streets. We work with landlords, legal service providers, fellow community-based organizations, and financial management programs to provide assistance to families in crisis.

Building Affordable Housing

Catholic Charities through Catholic Homes is a pioneer and leader in building and sustaining permanent affordable housing. We develop safe housing for families, seniors, and individuals based on our belief that having a home is a sacred human right.

We have over 2,900 units of affordable housing – including family, senior, and supportive housing units – and are building more.

Providing a Continuum of Care

Housing is just the beginning. Whether providing permanent affordable housing, emergency shelter, nutritious food, mental health services, job training, mentorship and youth programs for children, or referrals to other providers, we aim to extend full services to our homeless clients.

Helping Clients Get Back on Their Feet

"Through Catholic Charities, I found out there is love out there," says Dina Smalls, a mother of four and formerly homeless client. In addition to providing housing, Catholic Charities of New York helped Ms. Smalls with a range of support services, including life skills workshops and one-on-one mentoring sessions to help her become self-sufficient and get back on her feet.

"Catholic Charities is different. They helped me grow into the person that I am today," says Ms. Smalls. "There are people out there that genuinely care, people that you can reach out to. I can always reach out to Catholic Charities, no matter what. I am just so blessed that I have Catholic Charities," says Ms. Smalls.







Caring for Children and Youth

99,000+ Youth Provided Care

All children deserve the opportunity to learn social skills, gain confidence, and develop lasting values. From our dropout prevention and after-school programs to preventive services and foster care, our network of lifesaving services is addressing the physical, emotional, and psychological needs of children and their families.

Fostering Future Leaders

The Summer Youth Employment Program provides valuable work experience to thousands of low-income teens and young adults across the city.

We enrolled thousands of participants – providing life-changing experiences. Participants explored different interests and career pathways, developed productive workplace habits, and engaged in learning experiences that strengthen their social, civic, and leadership skills. They also received a valuable paycheck – up to \$2,000 for older workers in the program. The paycheck is a lifeline for lower-income families and for those with college costs.

Jailin Rodriguez, 15, learned about the need to help her community through career counseling offered by the program. "Homeless people need shelter. There are people who lack education. There is a lack of food. We are learning about how we can help our communities," says Ms. Rodriguez. There are many problems in her community, and she wants to help solve them. Her goal is to become a lawyer one day.

Providing young people with opportunities to further their education and career prospects is critical to strengthening our communities.

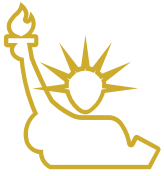

Creating Unforgettable Experiences

For children, summertime is about friendship-building and memory-making fun. We provide solid summer day camp experiences for children, especially for kids who come from vulnerable and low-income communities – all free of charge. We deliver experiences that have a life-changing impact.

"It's difficult to put a price on what we do," says Eddie Silverio, Director of Youth Programs at Catholic Charities Community Services. "This past summer, we enrolled almost 400 students just in day camp services alone."

For decades, Catholic Charities of New York has offered city kids a chance to enjoy a slice of summer life in rural Putnam Valley. A busload of students from Highbridge Gardens residential community in the West Bronx visited one of our campgrounds. Students enjoyed a day of sports, lawn games, and catching butterflies on the tranquil grounds. "This is my favorite field trip. The best part of my summer has been coming here!" says one student.



Welcoming and Integrating Immigrants

108,000+ People Served

We are committed to welcoming the stranger and recognizing the inherent dignity of every person. Through our immigrant and refugee assistance work, we support immigrants and refugees in their new homes here in New York. We help newcomers secure housing, learn English, prepare for citizenship, apply their talents to gain employment, and much more. This work would not be possible without you.

Building Essential Skills at the International Center

The International Center supports immigrants in realizing their goals and helps integrate them into life in New York and the United States. The center's programming includes English classes, citizenship preparation classes, computer skills workshops, one-on-one conversation practice, and other specialized programs.

"We serve people from over 80 different countries," says Elaine Roberts, Director of Programs at the International Center. "Everyone we meet is here because they have chosen to be here. They have said, 'I want a better job,' or 'I want to go to college,'" says Ms. Roberts.

"We greatly appreciate all the help and support that we got from the International Center and Catholic Charities. It makes the process of assimilation of immigrants much easier," says Iryna and Sergei Yemelyanenko from Belarus, who became American citizens this past year.

Opening a New Day Laborers Center

Catholic Charities of New York celebrated the opening of our new Day Laborers Center in Yonkers this past summer. Obreros Unidos Day Laborers Center connects businesses, contractors, and homeowners with skilled day laborers for a variety of services, ensuring fair wages and good working conditions.

The new resource center is an investment in the community – supporting immigrants working as day laborers to become part of New York's formal economy. Workers can receive educational training, legal counsel, OSHA-certified construction safety and skills, high-level training for electricity and scaffolding, and much more at the new resource center.

"We have enrichment classes from English classes to guitar classes, nanny training, and nail care. We also have English conversation partnerships," says Lucia Goyen, Director of Day Laborer Programs.

The center also educates workers on how to prevent wage theft from employers who pay workers less than what they were promised. It is a social watchdog and advocate within the community for day laborers. The center has helped recover more than \$60,000 in stolen wages. "Obreros Unidos is standing up for us," says Jose Antonio Galdamaz, a day laborer. "You are saving our lives."

Supporting Families in Crisis

138,000+ People Supported

We know that strong families build strong communities. Catholic Charities of New York provides guidance, referrals, and direct support to families in crisis – from child welfare and maternity services to family counseling and financial assistance. We could not provide help to families across New York without you. Your generosity has created hope for thousands of families in need.

Supporting Mothers and Newborns

Mothers in crisis often feel helpless and don't know where to turn for support. That's when Catholic Charities of New York steps in to help. We provide mothers with the support system they need to ensure safer pregnancies, healthier infants and children, and stronger families.

In partnership with Catholic Guardian Services, we provide mothers with a designated support person, such as a social worker, to address their needs. They also make home visits to provide one-on-one counseling and pregnancy resources.

"When I first met my social worker, I felt peaceful. She helped me a lot. Before, I couldn't speak to anyone about my problems. I feel a lot better anytime I talk to her," said a mother of four children and client.

Social workers provide critical counseling and support to mothers in crisis. "My favorite part of working with the families is seeing their confidence build. I let them know they have a place they can turn to," said a maternity services social worker who provides one-on-one counseling.

New York has one of the highest maternal mortality rates in the country. Each year in New York City, approximately 3,000 women die or almost die during childbirth from largely



preventable causes. Women of color are impacted most. Black women are eight times more likely than white women to die from pregnancy-related causes.

No woman should die bringing life into the world. Catholic Charities of New York and its agencies are responding to this maternal health crisis.

Expectant mothers have access to free parenting classes that teach them how to care for themselves during pregnancy, feed and care for a newborn, understand a child's developmental milestones, and strengthen their families. In addition to parenting classes, we help mothers access pre- and post-natal care, financial assistance, and childcare supplies, such as cribs and layettes.

Thanks to your critical support, we prevent maternal deaths and support mothers and their newborns.



Assisting the Disabled

4,800+ People Assisted

Disabilities come in many forms – both visible and invisible. We offer a network of specialized disability support services to help seniors adjusting to blindness, developmentally disabled children, teens and adults dealing with alcohol and substance abuse, and those with behavioral and emotional challenges.

Addressing the Mental Health Crisis

We know that mental health is essential for a healthy life. That's why we help New Yorkers struggling with serious mental illness with a range of critical services, especially housing opportunities. We provide a support system to people struggling with serious mental illness to help reintegrate them into the community.

People experiencing homelessness are disproportionately affected by severe mental illness. However, not all people who are homeless have a mental illness. Many people are homeless primarily because they cannot afford housing.

For New Yorkers who struggle with serious mental illness and are homeless, Beacon of Hope – a division of Catholic Charities Community Services – provides a continuum of housing opportunities that supports re-entry and integration in the community.

Beacon of Hope's need-based housing includes licensed community residences that provide 24-hour supervised group living arrangements where case managers are available to assist residents in meeting their personal goals and objectives.

We work closely with individuals in our residential programs to help negotiate the tasks of daily



living, cope with psychiatric and medical crises, seek employment, and support recovery from addiction. Every person is treated with dignity and respect.

"We have a huge population of individuals who are struggling with mental health," said Doreen Gardiner, Director of Staten Island and Brooklyn Apartment Programs with Beacon of Hope. "A way to incorporate them back into society – to be the best version of themselves and to be on a foundation that is healthy for them and others – is to provide them with support and to provide them with homes."

In the Bronx, Astor Services provides support to youth suffering with mental health challenges through a series of clinics, a therapeutic nursery and a growing presence throughout the public school system. They also serve Bronx residents of all ages at their new Trauma Recovery Center to provide Help, Healing and Hope to survivors of trauma.

Emergency Response

Assisting Asylum Seekers



More than 210,000 migrants have arrived in New York since the spring of 2022, creating an intense crisis.

Catholic Charities of New York has risen to meet this new challenge by partnering with the city to address the immediate and long-term needs of asylum seekers: food, shelter, intake forms, assessments, one-on-one consultations, case management, legal services, referrals, and more.

In order to expand our capacity to serve the legal needs of asylum seekers, we launched a New York Legal Response Project.

"The moment that asylum seekers began to arrive, I knew that Catholic Charities was going to be a strong partner in all this work," says Commissioner Manuel Castro of the Mayor's Office of Immigration Affairs.

All the while, we have adhered to our mission – to uphold the dignity of each person as made in the image of God by serving their basic needs.

"We are serving people every single day with dignity, compassion, and respect – allowing people to be who they are and contribute their skills to the world," says Kelly Agnew-Barajas, Co-Director, Immigrant & Refugee Services Division, Catholic Charities Community Services.
